In Hebrew a Vav can be a consonant or a vowel but can not be both or it goes against the grammatical rules of Hebrew. The letter Vav is actually pronounced as waw. Yod correlates to I in English not Y. There is no English C, F, J, V correlating to the Modern Semetic Hebrew Aleph Bet. Sometime after 1611 CE the I was often replaced by Y or J.
